



YCDTC is growing and has many events planned each year. In order to make sure all the events are successful and run smoothly, a lot of volunteer help is needed from club members. In the past, a minority of members have done the majority of volunteering. The YCDTC Board of Directors would like to see more members involved in club activities.

In order to encourage more member involvement, the Board has voted the following policy into effect beginning with the 2011 Award year:

All members who earn titles during the calendar year are eligible to receive an annual award. In order to get the award at no cost, members must attend one meeting and volunteer two times during the calendar year. General membership meetings, Board meetings, and the annual election meeting qualify for the meeting requirement. Volunteer activities include but are not limited to: sanctioned performance events, public education activities; and, scheduled committee and planning meetings. Members who earn titles but do not meet the above requirements may purchase the annual award at actual cost. Event chairpersons should have a sign-in paper at all events. Members are responsible for signing the paper if they volunteer at the event. Event chairpersons will turn the papers in to Gail Deller, who will be tracking meeting attendance and volunteer work. Gail Deller will have all records given to her at meetings she attends. Both YCDTC and TNT events are included for volunteer requirements. Events sponsored by Bella Vista are not club events and volunteering at these events does not count toward club volunteer requirements. See both YCDTC and TNT websites for scheduled activities.
